


HOLI CELEBRATION 2015: 5th March 2015


ANNUAL DAY : 2nd May 2015


About Parle-G, Parle Products was established as confectionery in the Vile Parle suburb of Mumbai, in 1929. It began manufacturing biscuits in 1939. In 1947, when India became independent, the company launched an ad campaign, showcasing its 'Gluco' brand of biscuits as an Indian alternative to the British biscuits. Parle-G biscuits were earlier called 'Parle Gluco' Biscuits until the 1980s. The "G" in the name Parle-G originally stood for "Glucose", though a later brand slogan also stated "G means Genius". In 2013, Parle-G became India's first domestic FMCG brand to cross the ₹5,000 Crore in retail sales. The entire visit was very informative and enlightening.



Trip to Parliament Museum: 16th March 2015

The Institute organized a trip to Parliament Museum on 16th March 2015 for Elite Group Students. The main objective of the visit was to make students aware about the freedom struggle of India. A total of 54 students along with 2 faculty members visited the museum. After the security check, the museum guide took over going through storytelling, paintings of significant leaders, an evocative audiovisual on 1857, collections of the first speaker G.V. Mavlankar, the uniform of the marshal of the central legislative assembly, the original chair of the first Prime Minister of India, a replica of the Constitution and memorable artifacts of Mahatma Gandhi, etc. Students heard some Patriotic songs of their choice which were recorded in 22 languages and a documentary on Transfer of Power was also shown to them. Students also had an emotional experience of walking alongside Mahatma Gandhi, in the Dandi March of 1930, in a virtual reality exhibit. An animatronics speech of Pt. Jawaharlal Nehru, which he delivered on the midnight of 14-15 August 1947 was also attended by students.

The Parliament Museum also displays the portraits of national leaders unveiled in the Central Hall from time to time, apart from the artifacts and souvenirs received from different countries and preserved in the Archives. The trip was very informative for students as they not only learned about the freedom struggle of India but also saw an excellent use of technology.

Faculty Club Meeting: 10th January 2015

The inaugural session of the national seminar was attended by eminent speakers like Rajesh Rishi, Member of Legislative Assembly (MLA), Janakpuri Constituency, Dr. Sanjiv Mittal, Dean- University School of Management Studies (USMS), GGSIP University and Professor Prodyut Bhattacharya, Ex-Dean, University School of Environment Management (USEM), GGSIP University. The confluence of esteemed and learned dignitaries familiarized the participants with the importance of Sustainable Development Practices and how it is the only way forward for a growing world economy.

The first technical session was Chaired by Prof. Bikram Kesari Pattanaik, IGNOU and was Co-Chaired by Mr. Rajiv Ralhan, Energy Auditor, Pricewaterhouse Coopers India. The session focused on Perspectives on Sustainable Development. The session facilitated the exchange of opinions and expertise of distinguished speakers and brought forward different perspectives on Sustainable Development such as the role of women and youth in sustainable development, corporate governance, entrepreneurial education and significance of developing green buildings. National Conference on Cyber Security- A Panoramic View: 21st March, 2015

IITM Group of Institutions in association with DeitY and CERT-In, Government of India organized a day-long National Conference on Cyber Security: A Panoramic View on 21st March, 2015 in IITM campus.



The conference registered a confluence of eminent dignitaries and experts. Dr. B. J. Srinath, Sr. Director, CERT-In, DeitY was the chief guest for the occasion. Dr. P.K Saxena OS/SC 'H', Director, SAG, DRDO was the Guest of Honor for the occasion. In his inaugural address, Dr. B. J. Srinath stressed on how IT has to undergo a much needed change and improvise on its various dimensions. His deliberation was focused over Cyber Novelties in the current era. In keynote address, Dr. P.K. Saxena highlighted about cyber space and the importance of 'Cyber Security Risk Analysis'.

He emphasized that the major concern of the cyber security was to access the mechanisms required to handle bits and bytes of information on the web. The inaugural address concluded with the release of conference souvenir by the honorable guest and presentation of mementos to the distinguished guests by Prof. (Dr). C.P. Chawla.

The first technical session was Chaired by Ms. Anu Khosla, Scientist-G, SAG, DRDO. Dr. A.K. Mohapatra was our distinguished panelist. Ms. Khosla initiated the first technical session by introducing the topic “Securing Critical Infrastructure”. She talked about various cyber attacks being done today and the reasons associated with it which included increasing dependence on networking. Dr. Anup Girdhar, CEO & Founder Sedulity Solutions, Editor –in-Chief Cyber Time highlighted vulnerabilities associated while accessing cyber space and the problems in using various protocols like SMTP, HTTPS. Dr. A.K.Mohapatra, Associate Professor, IGIT, Panelist cum speaker, delivered his talk on cryptographic research, application areas and pre- requisites of learning cryptography. Technical Session I was concluded by Dr. Anurag jain, Additional Coordinator Weekend Program, USICT, who illuminated all about internet phishing and its types like spear phishing, whaling, rogue (Wi Fi).
