

FAQ on Admission Process

1. What should be done in case any payment has been made more than once?

Any additional payment will be refunded back to the candidates. In case of any non-payment of the due amount, applicants may visit University Help Desk.

2. Can I apply for more than one CET?

Yes. However, -a separate application form has to be filled for each programme having distinct CET Codes.

3. What are the criteria for reservation of University?

The reservation policy is uploaded in the Admission Brochure 2019-20

4. What is the procedure for admission in GGSIPU?

The admission in GGSIPU is on the basis of merit obtained in CET. The dates for inviting application for appearing in CET are advertised through newspaper and notifications uploaded on the University website www.ipu.ac.in. The process for issue of notification for application for CET 2019 has commenced. Those who qualify CET are required to participate in the Counseling process for seeking admission, based on the candidate's preferences and his/her merit in CET 2019 in the respective programmes given specific CET codes.

5. I am aware that admissions in GGSIPU are based on CET merit and one has to participate in the Counseling process. How do I know the dates for Counseling?

This Year University is conducting Online Counseling for 11 programmes. The details with names of the programmes and the schedule have been uploaded on the University website www.ipu.ac.in & www.ipuadmissions.nic.in.

6. Please give me the list of Programme for which Online Counseling is being conducted. Also, candidates may refer to the Offline Counseling schedule for counseling to be held manually/offline.

7. What is the process of online allotment of seat?

The detail of Online allotment of seat is available in the Admission Brochure 2019-20. All the candidates who wish to seek admission through online process for the respective CET Codes for which Online Counseling is being held and should log on to www.ipuadmissions.nic.in at the time of admission.

8. Do I need to submit any document if pursuing course through distance learning mode?

In case of students who have passed the qualifying examination through distance/ open education system of any recognized university/ board/institution, the necessary documentary evidence related to location of his/her study centre i.e. study centre proof, certificate from the university imparting open/distance education certifying the location of study centre must be submitted at the time of verification.

9. Who are eligible to be considered in Delhi Region?

If the student has passed the qualifying examination from Delhi, the admission is permissible under Delhi Region. For details, may refer to Admission Brochure 2019-20.

10. How many seats are reserved for Delhi and OD region?

Generally, 85% of the sanctioned intake shall be allocated for Delhi region and 15% of the sanctioned intake shall be allocated for OD region.

11. Is there any rounding off of percentage of marks in qualifying marks?

No, rounding off of the percentage.

12. What is the upper age limit in UG and PG programmes?

For UG: 21 years.

For PG: 35 years.

13. Who is the final authority regarding reservation policy?

Final decision regarding reservation policy will be taken by the government of NCT of Delhi and the same will be announced on university website.

14. Is there any Management Quota in USMS?

There is no Management Quota in USMS.

15. What if I have passed the qualification examination from Delhi and reservation certificate has been issued from OD for SC/ST category?

Admission is permissible only under Delhi general category.

16. If someone is already studying in the university, is eligible for fresh admission or not?

Yes, but must submit the cancellation certificate at the time of verification of documents.

17. When to apply the option of freeze is the online admission process?

May refer to admission brochure for details, however one can opt for freezing only if he/she absolutely satisfied/sure about the allotted seat and do not wish to upgrade to higher choices/preference in the subsequent round of counseling.

18. How to download admit cards for the CET's?

19. What is the procedure to apply online, especially registration and payment of registration fees?
