
Workshop on Digital Marketing: 16th February 2021

- Short term vs. Long term Digital Marketing plans



Summer Training in Advanced Excel: 4th March to 24th March2021











FDP on Data Science Using R: 13th March 2021




Summer training in Advanced Excel: 15th to 27th March 2021












ROUTEMAP



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
