The following were the resolution for the last meeting:

- The research policy of the institute was updated to incentivize the faculties undertaking research and FDPs.

- Students who were not able to find internships online were also given the opportunity to do the internships at the institute level.
- Alumni talks were a continued feature to mentor the students.
- New books were procured as per the new syllabus.

- ICT membership was renewed.
- Guest Lecture and Industrial visits were organised for holistic development.
- Recreational Trip to Manali was organised for the final year students.
