- National Social Service (NSS) Units were established to meet the curriculum requirements.
- Workshops on advanced excel, R and python were conducted for students to bridge the skill gap
- New computers with latest configuration were purchased and installed in the labs.
- Water coolers were replaced on all the floors
- UGC approved special issue of the journal was published
- Proposal for declaring 3rd Saturday of the month as a holiday for better engagement of faculty and staff
- Recruitments were been conducted to hire HRs, academic staff and teaching faculties with requisite knowledge and skills
- New companies were been approached for internships and placement opportunity
- Industrial visits were been conducted for students of second and third year
