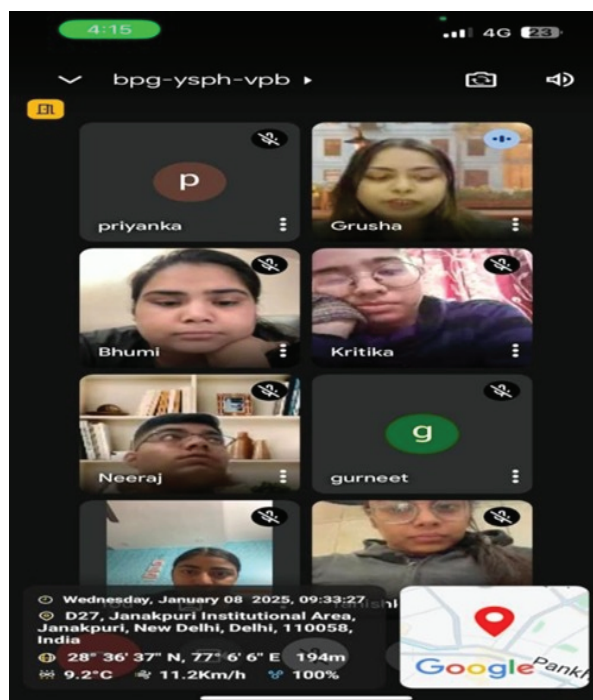
New Year Celebration-2025- 1st Jan, 2025

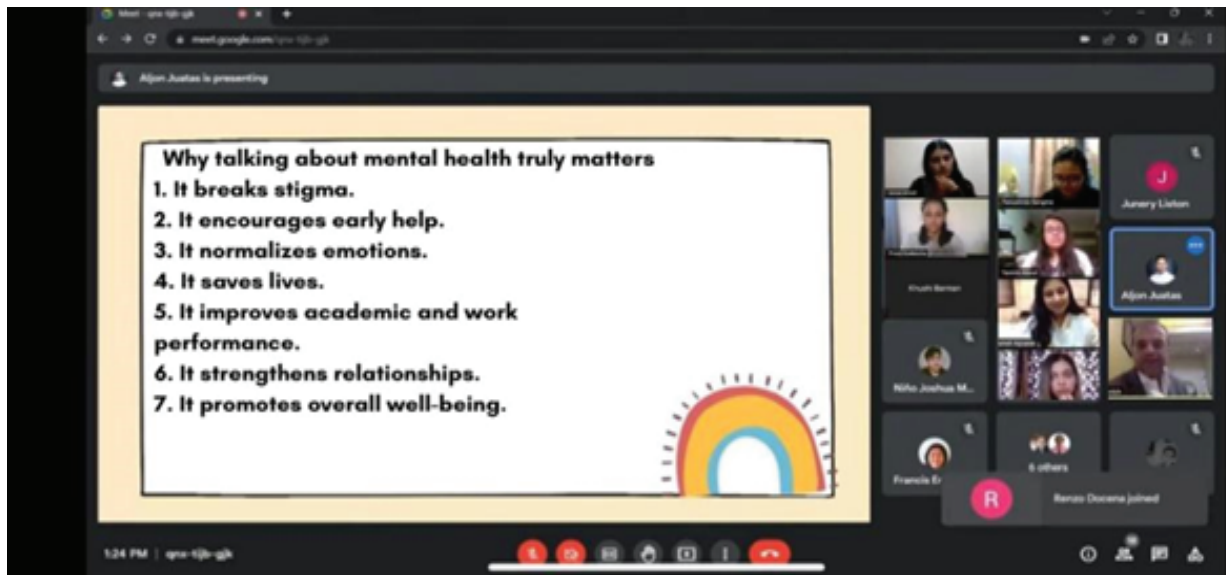
Path to placement : Resume and LinkedIn optimisation- 8th November, 2025

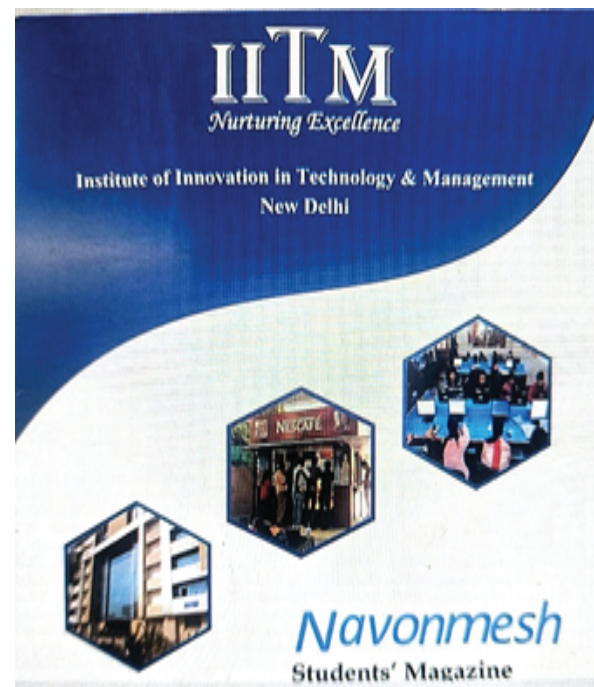
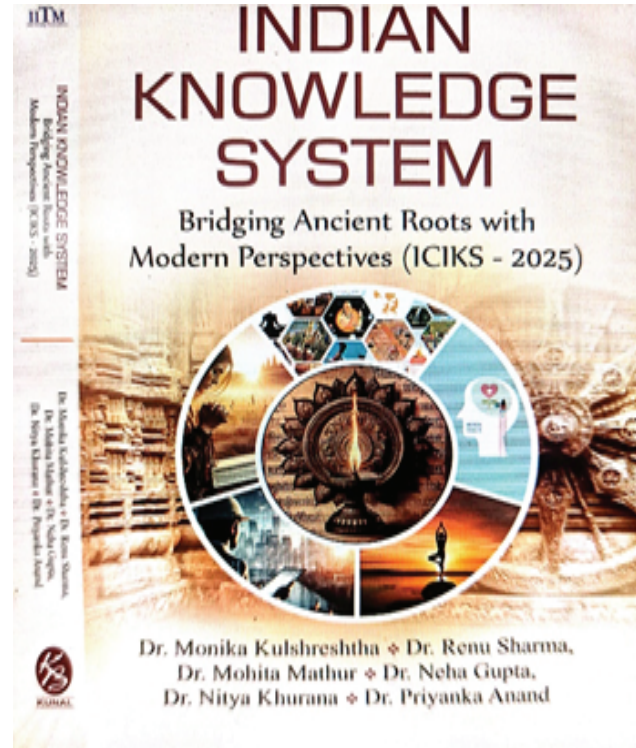
Christmas Day Celebration- 24th December 2025

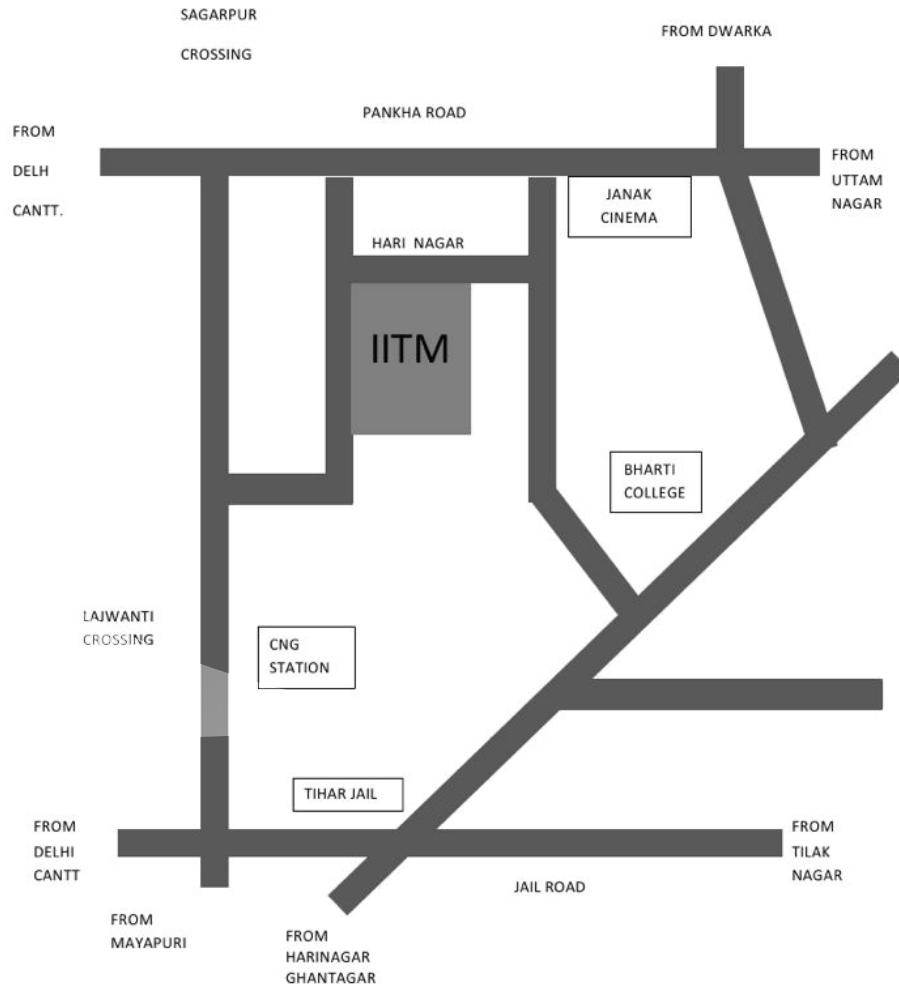
